On 22 July 2019 Lincolnshire County Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that part of Public Footpath No.11 in the parish of Colsterworth running from an unaffected part of Public Footpath No.11 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SK 9439 2223 (A) in a generally east south easterly direction for approximately 300 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SK 9465 2209 (B) then continuing in a generally easterly direction for approximately 552 metres to terminate at Honeypot Lane at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SK 9520 2210 (C). The total length of footpath to be diverted to be approximately 852 metres as shown between points A-B-C on Order Drawing numbered 2017/020/PPO343/A4 TO AN ALTERNATIVE ROUTE in the parish of Colsterworth to be 2 metres wide running from an unaffected part of Public Footpath No.11 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SK 9439 2223 (A) in a generally east south easterly direction for approximately 173 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SK 9454 2216 (D) then continuing in a generally southerly direction for approximately 254 metres to terminate at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference SK 9453 2191 (E) at Honeypot Lane. The total length of footpath to be added to be approximately 427 metres as shown between points A-D-E on Order Drawing numbered 2017/020/PPO343/A4



Any person who wishes to claim compensation under section 28 as applied by section 121(2) of the 1980 Act for depreciation or damage for disturbance arising as a result of the coming into force of the Order must make a claim in writing addressed to the Chief Legal Officer, Legal Services Lincolnshire, Lincolnshire County Council, 45-49 Newland, Lincoln, LN1 1YS, marked for the attention of Sally Ironmonger and quoting reference SXI.ENV024127.COLSTERWORTH and serve it by delivering it

at, or sending it by prepaid post to, that address not later than 20 February 2020. A copy of the sections is attached.

The Order comes into force as from 19 August 2019 but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity of it, or of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 2 August 2019 make an application for the purpose in the High Court.
